Decal and sticker compliance guide

What each decal and sticker is, where it belongs on the machine, and how the annual renewal cycle works — for every location Supreme services.

What each decal or sticker covers

Annual Georgia Lottery Corporation decal CABINET

Every machine carries a decal issued fresh each license year. It identifies the master license assigned to that cabinet — for Supreme's fleet, master license #15226. The decal is placed on the exterior of the cabinet where an inspector or player can see it without opening the machine.

Responsible-play sticker CABINET

Every machine displays a responsible-play sticker at the cabinet, visible to the player during play. This sticker is separate from the annual decal and does not change on a license-year cycle — it stays on the machine as standard equipment.

Master license certificate GAME ROOM

The current master license certificate is displayed in the game room, not on an individual cabinet. It confirms the location is operating under a licensed master — Supreme Gaming Group LLC, Georgia COAM Master License #15226, licensed since 2014.

Annual renewal cycle

Georgia Lottery Corporation decals are issued for a license year, not indefinitely. When a license year turns over, every machine under a master's license needs its decal replaced with the current year's issue. An expired decal on the cabinet is a compliance gap the same as a missing one.

Who handles it

Supreme Gaming Group is responsible for every decal and sticker on every machine it places. Renewal, placement, and verification are built into the regular service route — a location owner does not need to track renewal dates, order decals, or apply anything themselves.
